# Registration of Non-Namibian Adjudicators

## for nomination to Dispute Adjudication Boards

**The following shall apply with immediate effect:**

1. In principle, adjudicators that are not resident in Namibia will be allowed to be registered on the National Adjudicator's List (NAL);
2. Prior agreement by contracting Parties: For the nomination of non-resident adjudicators to Dispute Boards, a specific set of conditions would apply as follows:
  - 2.1 The contracting Parties (Contractor and Employer) would need to agree and indicate in their application form, that such foreign adjudicators be considered;
  - 2.2 The onus of compliance with the Namibian law with regard to work permits and professional registration (as required) would be on the contracting Parties and the non-resident adjudicator, and they would be required to indemnify the EPA accordingly.

- 3 Minimum credits for registration on the NAL: Applicants resident in other countries where professional registration is required by law, must accordingly be registered in such country. Note: such persons forfeit the credits for A.1 and A.2, which implies such forfeited credits must be earned through higher credits on the experience-based sections.
- 4 Nominations: Adjudicators registered on the NAL and that reside outside Namibia will only be considered for nominations to DAB's on construction projects:
  - 4.1 That have been reserved for 'Senior Adjudicators' in terms of value;
  - 4.2 Where the DAB is a 3-member DAB, and the other two members are resident in Namibia;
  - 4.3 Where the Parties have agreed to include adjudicators that reside outside Namibia.
