NOTES:

- b) An Associate Member is one who is registered with the Engineering Council of Namibia as a Professional Engineer in training, or Incorporated Engineer in training or Engineering Technician in training or any graduate not registered with the Engineering Council of Namibia. Also persons who do not qualify for registration with the Engineering Council of Namibia but who are involved in other profession closely related to or supportive to the engineering profession and who are engaged in work supportive of the engineering profession will be granted Associate membership as non-registrable members.
- c) A Student member is one who is studying at any institution to become a Professional Engineer or Engineering Technician but yet not registerable as an Associate member.
